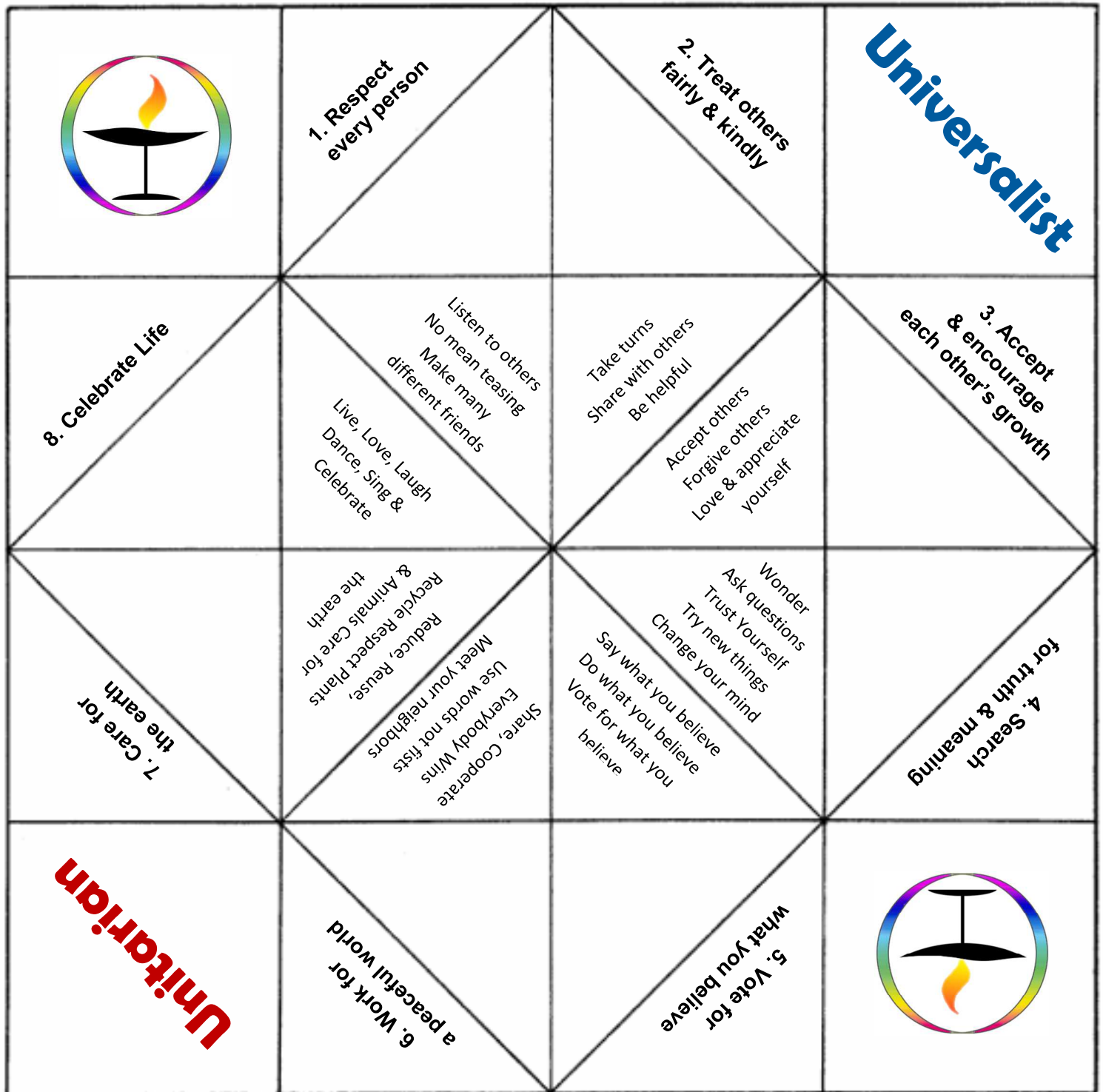


UU Principles Fortune Teller





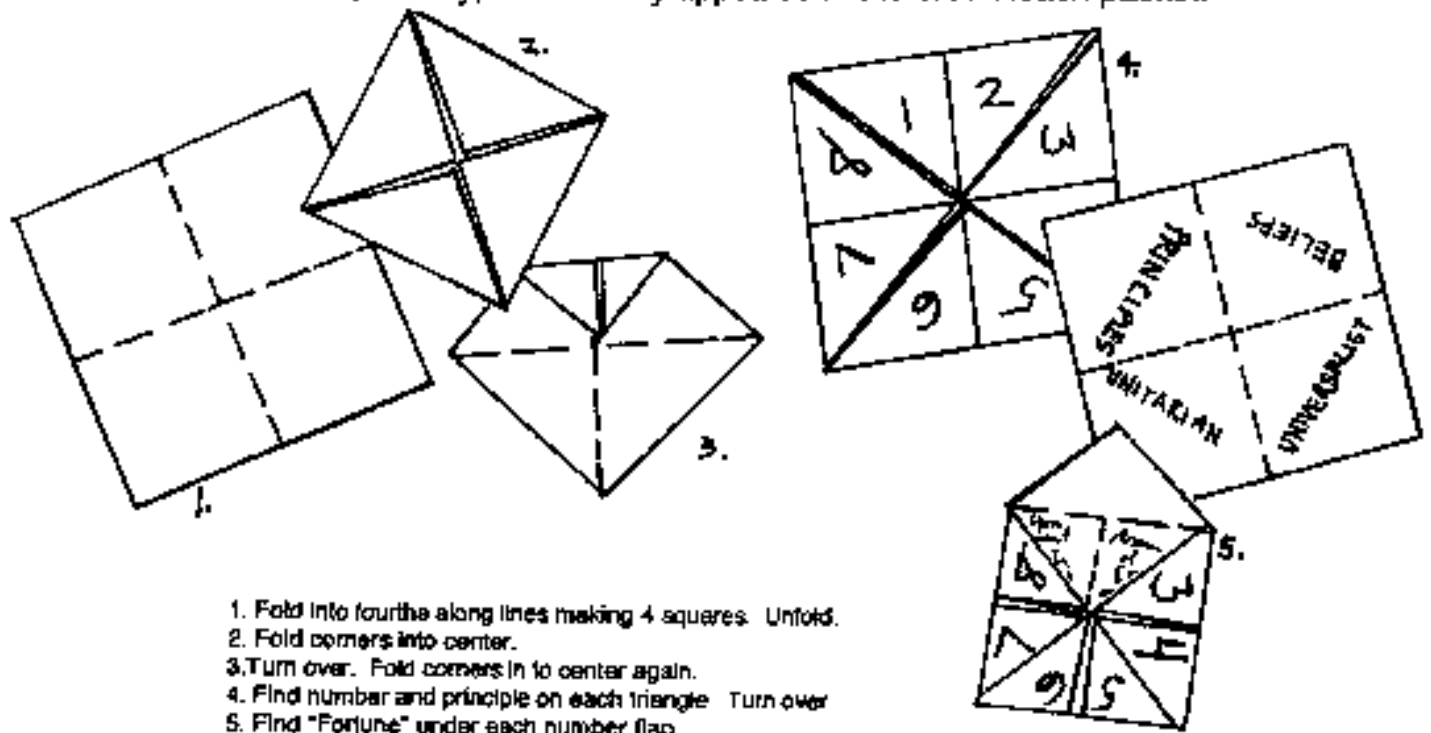
U.U. PRINCIPLES FORTUNE TELLER

During the Meadville Winter Institute a small group brainstormed ways to live our U.U. Principles. We wanted to incorporate them into a U.U. Principles Fortune Teller. Our idea was to have every Unitarian Universalist girl and boy have something that they could fold up in their pocket, purse or school bag. When asked about what they believe, they could pull

out their *U. U. Principles Fortune Teller* and show their friends what they believe and how they live those beliefs. For example when you lift up the Principle #4 *Search for Truth and Meaning* you find how to live this principle. *Ask Questions, Try new things, Trust yourself, Wonder about things, Be willing to change your mind.*

Feel free to copy or adapt the idea in any way you want. We're sure our children will find creative ways to use them. Perhaps they will want to illustrate each Principle or come up with their own ideas for living them. We are interested in what you do with this idea and any adaptations you create. Directions for folding the Fortune Teller come from Brenda Chin, United First Parish, Quincy, MA as they appeared in the 9/87 Reach packet.



1. Fold into fourths along lines making 4 squares. Unfold.
2. Fold corners into center.
3. Turn over. Fold corners in to center again.
4. Find number and principle on each triangle. Turn over
5. Find "Fortune" under each number flap
